Web Jan 4, 2022 · A traditional view is that hell is in the center of the earth Others propose that hell is located in outer space in a black hole In the Old Testament, the word translated "hell" is Sheol; in the New Testament, it's Hades (meaning "unseen") and Gehenna ("the Valley of Hinnom") Sheol is also translated as "pit" and "grave" Both Sheol and Hades refer to a temporary abode of the dead before judgment (Psalm 9:17; Revelation 1:18)
